This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.93 dated 30.09.2020 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to him, at the relevant stage before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

petitioner is 68 years old and is also handicapped and thus, prays that his personal appearance before the trial Court may kindly be exempted
