Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents No.4 and 5 have repeatedly raped the petitioner No.1 and she lodged FIR No.155 dated 07.06.2021, registered for offences under Sections 376-C, 120-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Tabri, District Ludhiana against them, who forced the petitioner to execute the false affidavit (Annexure P-2). Counsel has submitted that as respondent No.4 is posted

as Sub-Inspector, he is exerting pressure on petitioner No.1 and her family members. He submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation dated 18.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, but the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation (Annexure P-3).

Having considered the request made by the counsel for the petitioners, without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to examine the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner No.1 and thereafter to take appropriate suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful within a period of four weeks from the receipt of this order.
