The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 40 dated 04.02.2021, registered under Sections 379, 411 of the IPC and Sections 2, 41, 42, 52, 55 and 69 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.09.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Constable Satish, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 02.09.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
