Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.132 dated 29.07.2017, registered at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana Rural, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been regularly appearing before the trial Court; that on 26.10.2021, the petitioner was present in the Court, but owing to the rush of work or inadvertence, his presence could not be marked, following which his bail was cancelled and bonds forfeited.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days and move an appropriate application seeking relief of regular bail there and, thus, confines his prayer to the issuance of directions to the trial Court to

decide the said bail application of the petitioner, within a stipulated period.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and move an application seeking the relief of regular bail there. On his doing so, the said application for bail shall be decided within two days thereafter.
