[1] Prayer in the instant petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11& 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.09.2021 in CWP No.18729 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.18729 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider representations dated 05.12.2018 and 16.07.2019 as well as legal notice dated 24.06.2021 and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within 01 month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled and there was no impediment for the release of payment, to release the same to

[3] Learned Addl. AG, along with Shri R.D. Bawa, learned counsel for respondent No.3 states that needful has been done and claim of the petitioner decided. Decision as produced is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 14.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
