JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition is seeking direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the representation dated 11.02.2021 (Annexure P-1).

2. The respondent-State by way of affidavit dated 20.04.2021 filed status report disclosing that petitioner is not residing at the address disclosed in the petition. The jurisdictional SHO deputed the ASI Rajesh Kumar to record the statement of petitioner, however, ASI Rajesh Kumar could not find out petitioner residing at given address and her daughter in law stated that petitioner is not residing at given address since last 5-6 years. The further inquiry was conducted from councillor of ward No.7, who stated that petitioner is not residing at given address. The Police

Commissioner, Jalandhar has issued instruction to all Police Stations falling in its jurisdiction not to taken any coercive steps against the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that an FIR No.245 dated 25.09.2021 under Section 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC has been registered against petitioner at Police Station Meerapur District Muzaffarnagar.

4. The status report dated 20.04.2021 filed by State and FIR dated 25.09.2021 filed by counsel for respondent No.4 is taken on record and Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

5. In view of the affidavit filed by learned State counsel and FIR lodged against the petitioner coupled with the facts that petitioner is not present at given address, no further order is warranted.

6. Disposed of.
