1. After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks, and, is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

2. Dismissed as withdrawn.

3. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner-accused to through an application filed under Section 311 Cr.P.C., claim relief, that the CCTV footages, if any, as were existing, at the site of occurrence or in proximity thereof be permitted to be adduced as defence evidence.

4. Moreover, liberty is also reserved to the petitioner-accused to adduce all documentary evidence for his being enabled to propagate the plea of *alibi*. The learned trial Judge is directed to expeditiously conclude trial, as arising from FIR No. 303 of 27.10.2019, lodged at Police Station IMT Rohtak, within three months hereafter.
