AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of private respondents and further directions be issued to respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the family of petitioner No. 1.

As per the pleadings, the petitioners had performed marriage against the wishes of their parents, hence, there is a threat perception.

On 1.3.2021 the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 8 as they have entered into marriage on 22.02.2021 against their wishes.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On request, adjourned to 26.03.2021.”

Reply had been filed by the learned State Counsel annexing the statements of both the petitioners. It is stated therein that they do not want to take any action against any one.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
