Vide this petition, the petitioners seek the issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing respondents no.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty, which are alleged to be in imminent danger at the hands of respondents no.4 to 6; and further they also seek a direction to respondent no.3 not to harass them unnecessarily.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the SSP, Patiala, to go into the grievance of the petitioners after hearing them and to take action as is required as per law thereafter.

It is made clear that this court has not made any observations on the merits of the case, but as regards any proceedings to be taken either against the petitioners or against respondents no.4 to 6, naturally proper notices etc. would be

issued to them strictly in compliance of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The SSP would go into the matter and take a decision thereon within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
