The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to expeditiously appoint a Presiding Officer/Chairman at the Central Government Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Chandigarh.

The needful has already been done and appointment of the Presiding Officer/Chairman at the Central Government Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Chandigarh Bench, has already been made and therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the same may be disposed of as not pressed.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move appropriate application in case post has fallen vacant on account of any subsequent development.

Needless to mention that the Presiding Officer/Chairman at the Central Government Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Chandigarh Bench, shall look into the grievances and considering the fact that the issue relates to industrial dispute appropriate steps for expeditious disposal of the reference shall be taken.
