The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the representations dated 21.08.2019 (Annexure P-9) and 22.12.2019 (Annexure P-10).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforementioned representations within time bound manner.

The prayer is innocuous.

Given above, respondent No.2-Director General of Police shall either himself decide the representations dated 21.08.2019 (Annexure P-9) and 22.12.2019 (Annexure P-10) or authorise any other officer to the rank of IPS by passing a speaking and reasoned order within 30 working days from today.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

The petition is partly allowed to the extent mentioned above. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
