SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

Present is a petition seeking quashing of order dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.B.S.Nagar in case bearing No. NACT/282/2019 titled as 'Krishan Lal Vs. Harpreet Singh', whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has contended that no notice was ever served upon the petitioner and his bailable warrants were ordered to be issued. Even no service of the bailable warrants was effected and resultantly the warrant of arrest and proclamation was issued.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the concerned Court and join the proceedings and the impugned order (Annexure P-4) be set aside.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.

Learned State Counsel has no objection if the petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned Court and join the proceedings.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court on or before 16.03.2022 and he will file an application for regular bail, which shall be decided by the learned trial Court, in accordance with law on the same very date and till then the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

With the aforesaid directions, the present petition stands disposed of.
