Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C
seeking direction to respondent No.2 to entertain application
(Annexure P-1) and decide the same, in accordance with law and for
quashing endorsement dated 15.02.2022.

In response to the notice issued by this Court, status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Bathinda, District Bathinda has been filed on behalf of State-respondent No.1, wherein, it has been submitted as under:-

“5. That both the applications were inquired into by ASI Prem Kumar 342/BTI, PP Court Complex Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda. During inquiry notice was issued to the girl Mansi who joined the inquiry and submitted her statement that (sic and) stated that I am residence (sic resident) of the above-mentioned address and I am (sic have) studied up (sic upto) 9th. I performed my marriage with Pintu on 02.01.2022 as per Hindu rites. UID card and PAN Card and even on my birth certificate my date of birth is showed (sic shown) 01.01.2004. My date of birth which is printed on my school living (sic leaving) certificate that is produced by my father showed birth date is (sic as) 20.02.2004 and the same is wrong in the school my date of birth was written with mere guess. But as per UID card and PAN Card and as per my birth certificate my date of birth is 01.01.2004 which is correct. I performed my marriage with my sweet will and I am living with my in-law family happily. I filed an complaint (sic u/s) 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC in the Court of JMIC Bathinda against my father Maya Ram, mother Sushila, brother Santosh, uncle Ravi and Aunt Meen all r/o Shanti Nagar slum area Bathinda. It was fixed for

03.02.2022 and the next date of hearing is 28.04.2022 for my presence and I will appear before the Ld. Court of JMIC Bathinda. My father is giving false complaints against my in-law family members. I am living with my in-laws family members happily and with my own will. I have no complaint against my father-in-law Shiv Kumar, mother-in-law, my husband and my sister-in-law and my brother-in-law. There is no coercion upon me regarding the marriage and I performed this marriage with my sweet will. Statement heard and it is correct.

6. That husband of Mansi name Pintu also joined the inquiry and recorded his statement that he had performed marriage with Mansi and did (sic do) the work of mobile repair. He said that with this marriage my family members are agreed but the family members of Mansi are not agreed. My wife had filed a complaint against Maya Ram and others in the Court of JMIC Bathinda u/s 323/324/506/148/149 IPC and which is pending for 28.04.2022. Myself and my wife Mansi are living at my house happily.

7. That petitioner did not join the inquiry even after the repeated telephonically calls made by the police.

8. That prior to this on 05.01.2022 Mansi had also filed a complaint u/s 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC against the present petitioner and her family members in the Court of Ld. JMIC

Bathinda and the same is pending for 28.04.2022.”

In view of the above and keeping in view the fact that victim claims to have attained the age of majority, nothing survives in the petition, which is hereby dismissed.
