Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present case, the pensionary benefits, for which, the petitioners are entitled for, in respect of the service, which they have rendered are not being extended to them by the respondents by fixing their pension after their superannuation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, the provisional pension is being paid to the petitioners but, the said provisional pension is not being finalized and false and frivolous objections are being taken by the office of the Accountant General, Punjab, despite the fact that the issue in question already stands decided by the said authority itself while dealing with the case of the similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the grievance, which is being raised in the present writ petition, the petitioners have already served the respondents with a representation dated 10.11.2021

(Annexure P/31), which is still pending consideration with the said respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in representation dated 10.11.2021 (Annexure P/31), respondent No.2 is directed to decide representation dated 10.11.2021 (Annexure P/31) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
