Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the order under challenge is of transfer passed in the year 2019 and the petitioner is continuing under the interim orders of this Court, hence, the present order of transfer will not be given effect to but liberty be given to the respondent-Department to transfer the petitioner henceforth in case his case is covered under the transfer policy while effecting the transfer henceforth.

Learned counsel for the petitioner raises no objection.

As the petitioner was transferred against respondent No.5 and respondent No.5 has also been adjusted in Hisar, the present petition is disposed of keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel that the transfer order in question will not be implemented qua the petitioner any further but the respondents will have liberty to transfer the petitioner in case his case is covered by the transfer policy invoked henceforth.

As the main case has been disposed of, applications i.e. CM-7083-CWP-2019 and CM-3322-CWP-2019 also stand disposed of.
