VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent-authorities to notify the election schedule including the formation of zones, voter lists, election programme as well as the conduct of election under the provisions of Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 and the rules framed thereunder.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from Gurpreet Singh, Inspector in the office of Registrar Cooperative Societies contends that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since election to the society has already been held on 10.01.2022. Thus, there is no remaining grievance or surviving cause of action.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner is

not in a position to controvert the same at this juncture.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case the above statement of the learned State counsel is found to be incorrect.
