[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders (Annexure P-1 & P-2) dated 30.09.2021 and 13.10.2021 in CWP No.19896 of 2021 and CM No.14968 of 2021 dated 13.10.2021.

[2] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case, however, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 02.03.2022 passed by the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Forests & Wildlife Department, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for counting *ad hoc* service for the purpose of seniority. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
