Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.373 dated 06.10.2019, under Sections 13 (3) and 3 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is based on secret information. It is alleged that 02 male and a female calves were tied in front of the house of the petitioner. Recovery of about 60-70 kgs of cow meat is alleged to have been made from a place which does not belong to the petitioner. The petitioner is 65 years of age.

This Court, by the order dated 06.12.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sandeep, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not disclosing the name of other accused.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 06.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
