GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file afresh.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Since this Court finds that in the instant petition following 3 separate reliefs have been sought, the petitioner would be well advised to file separate petitions:

- (i) quashing of FIR No.60 dated 27.07.2006 registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudharian, District Kapurthala, under Sections 406/420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act;
- (ii) setting aside of order dated 09.07.2007 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, under the provisions of Section 319 Cr.P.C.; &

- (iii) order dated 25.01.2008 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, vide which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender.
