The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain respondents no. 4 to 6 not to harass or interfere in their peaceful married life.

Vide order dated 01.03.2021, notice of motion was issued to the respondents no. 1 to 3 only.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. It has been stated in the status report that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court, the petitioners were called by the police and their statements were recorded. The petitioners stated before the

police that they had solemnized marriage with each other on 24.02.2021 and had filed the petition under apprehension of threats from their parents and other relatives. However, they did not apprehend any danger from anyone now and did not want to take any action on their petition.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed and the petition is disposed of, accordingly.
