1. The counsels appearing for the contesting litigants jointly submit that in case a sum of Rs. 6,30,000/- is paid by the accused to the complainant, thereupon, criminal complaint bearing No. 2564 of 18.04.2016/14.06.2016 would be withdrawn.

2. In view of the above statement, and, also when the making of an order for withdrawal of the petition complaint, can, be prayed for only before the learned trial Judge concerned, and, upon, respective appearances, being made there by the contesting litigants, thereupon, the petition, at this stage, does not survive, and, is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner-accused, and, the respondent-complainant to make their respective personal appearance(s) before the learned trial Magistrate concerned, on or before 31.05.2022. Upon theirs making

their respective personal appearances before the learned trial Judge, it is expected that the above made statement before this Court, is abided by each, if so, the learned trial Magistrate shall proceed to make an order terminating the complaint, or, an order of composition qua the complaint offences.

- 3. Disposed of accordingly.
- 4. Since the main case itself has been decided, all the pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
