On 02.03.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross case under Sections 323/324/326/354/354-B/148/149 IPC registered vide GD No. 31 dated 28.05.2020 in FIR No. 94 dated 26.05.2020 under Sections 323/324/326/354/354-B/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Ghoman, Police District Batala.

Learned counsel submits that it is a case of version and cross-version wherein both the parties received injuries at the hands of each other. He submits that the only injury attributed to the petitioner is a simple injury on the ring finger of the complainant.

Notice of motion for 01.08.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Upon instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, recovery has been effected from him and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
