B.S. Walia, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 11.01.2021 in CWP No.590 of 2021 in case titled as Veer Kaur and others vs. State of Haryana and others.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.590 of 2021 was disposed of with the direction that if the revision petition was pending before the revisional authority, the same be decided on or before the next date of hearing fixed before respondent No.2 i.e. Financial Commissioner, Haryana and that till then status quo be maintained and in case possession had been taken by the Gram Panchayat, the Gram Panchayat would be entitled to continue in possession of the property till the decision of the revision petition.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the revision petition has since been decided by the learned Financial

Commissioner against the petitioners and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge the decision of the learned Financial Commissioner dismissing the revision petition filed by the petitioners by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.

5. Rule discharged.
