Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0029 dated 11.02.2022 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Central, Sector 17, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise deed dated 21.02.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 02.03.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Area Magistrate on 16.03.2022 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 30.03.2022 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is

of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.0029 dated 11.02.2022 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Central, Sector 17, Chandigarh, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed, qua the petitioners.
