Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that keeping in view the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.556 of 2020 dated 21.01.2020, the petitioners who were eligible, had applied for the grant of permits but, despite lapse of two years, no information has been given to the petitioners with regard to the fate of their application submitted for the grant of permits. He further submits that the petitioners have been writing representation to the respondents, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-10 to P-16, which are still pending consideration with the respondent authorities and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional AG, Haryana, accepts

notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the representations filed by the petitioners and states that the representations (Annexures P/10 to P/16) submitted by the petitioners will be decided within a period of four weeks from today and in case, after the decision, it is found that any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken without any further delay.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, respondent No.2-The Transport Commissioner, Haryana is directed to decide representations (Annexures P/10 to P/16) submitted by the petitioners by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
