1. This review application has been filed for reviewing the order dated 17.09.2020, whereby the application bearing CM No.18131-CWP-2018 for revival of the above captioned writ petition has been dismissed.
2. Reply filed by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Maur, District Bathinda is taken on record. However, a document Annexure R-1 which has been supplied in a sealed cover is returned back to the learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General.
3. Having gone through the reply, we find that the original writ petition was disposed off as far back as on 25.09.2018. Thereafter, a revival application was filed and by order dated 18.10.2019 this Court constituted a fresh SIT. In view of that, ultimately on 17.09.2020 the application for revival of the above captioned writ petition was dismissed.
