Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.207 dated 25.11.2019, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 01.04.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, submits that although the petitioner has joined investigation, yet recovery of cash amount has not been effected. Otherwise, challan was presented on 07.09.2022.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
