ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had joined the investigation.

On instructions received from ASI Sanjeev Bhagna, learned State counsel does not refute the statement made by counsel for the petitioner.

Given above, petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.09.2021 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

1. Petitioner shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with the arms license to the concerned authority within ten days from today and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, he shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.
2. Within ten days, the petitioner shall mention details of all assets, held either individually or jointly, including bank balances, fixed deposits, DEMAT Accounts, to the Investigator and its copy to the complainant/victim(s).

In case, petitioner fails to comply with the above conditions, State as well as complainant may file application for cancellation of bail.
