This a petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0124 dated 20.10.2019 under Sections 363, 366, 376, (2N), 376D of IPC read with Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, registered at Police Station Section 19, U.T. Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he does not want to press the present petition and only restricts his prayer to the effect that appropriate directions may be given to the trial Court for early disposal of the case.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed, being not pressed.

The custody certificate indicates that the petitioner is in custody for a period of 2 years 9 months and 14 days. Learned State counsel informs that 14 witnesses have been examined so far. Keeping in view the period of incarceration, the learned trial Court is requested to look into the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the case in accordance with law.
