Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Assistant w.e.f. 24.07.2000 i.e. the date when her junior respondent No.3 was promoted.

2. Petition was admitted for hearing on 18.09.2003.

3. When taken up for final adjudication, after around 19 years, learned counsel is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite attempts, his office could not contact the petitioner. In the premise, no useful purpose would be served to issue fresh notice to the petitioner as the same too would be an exercise in futility.

4. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 18 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

5. Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
