On 04.03.2022, this court passed the following order:-

“Heard through Video Conferencing.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.333 dated 08.12.2021, registered for offences under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the matrimonial dispute between the parties has been settled by virtue of Compromise Deed dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) and a petition seeking quashing of the FIR has been separately instituted.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Prabhjot Singh Walia, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab and Mr. Bikramjit Singh Jatana, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of the State-respondent No.1 and complainant-respondent No.2 respectively.

List on 29.03.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M-54005-2021.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa on 10.03.2022 at 10.00 A.M. and join the investigation and would appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the husband and interim bail granted to Amarjeet Kaur, mother-in-law of the complainant in CRM-M-54005-2021, has been made absolute by an order passed on even date.

Keeping in view the above, petition is allowed.

Order dated 04.03.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
