The petitioner has preferred the instant revision petition under Section 401 Cr.P.C., against the judgment dated 04.02.2020, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 05.05.2018 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist class, Ludhiana has been dismissed.

This Court, vide order dated 19.03.2020, suspended the sentence of the petitioner while noticing the fact that compromise has been effected between the parties.

Today, the parties are present in person before this Court and they have been identified by their respective counsel. The parties are ad-idem that the matter stands compromised vide Memorandum of Understanding (Annexure A-1) dated 07.03.2020.
