Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 20.08.2001 (Annexure P-4) whereby claim of the petitioner for regularization of service as Beldar w.e.f. 01.02.1996 was rejected.

2. Petition was noticed for hearing on 04.09.2001.

3. When taken up for final adjudication, after around 21 years, Mr. R.Kartikeya, Advocate appears and submits that though his 'Power of Attorney' is not on record, however, he is appearing as a matter of professional courtesy since he knew the learned counsel, who filed the writ petition and he had expired during pendency of the writ proceedings. He submits that he tried to contact the petitioner but there has been no response from him. In the premise, no useful purpose would be served to issue fresh notice to the petitioner as the same too would be an exercise in futility.

4. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 21 years before this Court, either it has been rendered

infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

5. Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
