As per report of the trial Court, some of the accused, who have been granted the concession of bail either by this Court or by the trial Court, have absented from court proceedings and the proceedings under Sections 82/83 Cr.P.C. have been initiated against them.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to re-approach the trial Court in view of the new grounds.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

If the petitioner moves a regular bail application before the trial Court, the same shall be decided independently, without taking into consideration any observations made in the earlier orders while declining the grant of bail to the petitioner.
