1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 14.01.2021, in CWP-940-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 14.01.2021, reveals that CWP-940-2021, was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 15.11.2020, as representation and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to notice issued to respondent Nos.3 and 4, decision has been taken by the respondents in terms of order dated 14.01.2021, accepting the claim of the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent Nos.3 and 4, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
