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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.317 dated 11.11.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 354, 354-B and 506 IPC and Section 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

Briefly stated, the case of the prosecution is that the alleged victim is 14 years of age; the petitioner is her neighbourer; whenever the alleged victim used to go to school, the petitioner used to extend threats to her as also harass her and because of such threats she had to leave her studies.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on account of a dispute between the families of the petitioner and the alleged victim over drainage water.

Learned State counsel opposes the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner has threatened and harassed a 14 year old girl which led her to leave her studies as also for the reason that since only 01 prosecution witness remains to be examined in the petitioner's trial, at this stage, he should not be granted bail.

On way to her school, a 14 year old girl is alleged to have been threatened and harassed by the petitioner to such an extent that because of

such threats and harassment she had to leave her studies.

In the light of the above allegations as also at this stage of the petitioner's trial when only 01 prosecution witness remains to be examined it is considered undesirable to release the petitioner on bail.

Dismissed.

However, the Trial Court is directed to dispose of the petitioner's trial within two months from the date next fixed before it, in accordance with law.
