The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari to allow the petitioner to execute a personal bond in all different 24 cases instead of arranging 48 sureties in all the 24 different cases.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has so far not appeared before the Court and no order directing two sureties and/or condition of bail has been imposed.

The present petition is pre-mature. The petitioner is required at the first instance to appear before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate and to furnish bail bonds. Cause of action, if any, would accrue only thereafter. The present petition is accordingly dismissed as pre-mature at this stage.
