The Judgment Debtor prays for stay of the execution petition till the decision of the application filed by him under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC for setting aside the ex-parte decree. The decree is for recovery of the money.

Admittedly, an application filed for stay of further proceedings in the execution petition has been dismissed by the Court. The petitioner can always pay the amount with a right to pray for restitution as and when the ex-parte decree is set aside.

In view thereof, no ground to interfere is made out.
