[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.12.2021, in CRM-M No.53988 of 2021 in case titled as '**Sushil Kumar** versus **State of Punjab**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CRM-M No.53988 of 2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent (herein) to go into the representation of the petitioner and to take action in accordance with law within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the time taken by the learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, to file compliance report, reply has been filed along with copy of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 18.08.2022, rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the

same with liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 18.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.

[5] All the pending miscellaneous applications if any, stand disposed of.
