[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.11.2019 in CWP No.34029 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.11.2019 reveals that CWP No.34029 of 2019 was disposed of by directing The Commissioner cum Director General, School Education, Haryana to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-5 dated 25.09.2019 in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued. However, learned DAG has placed on record copy of order No.13/22-2022 HRME-I (3), Dated Panchkula, 03.12.2021 passed by the Director General Secondary Education Haryana, Panchkula rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record, copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who

instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 03.12.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
