Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0170 dated 23.8.2021 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Sections 66, 66(C) of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station City-2, Khanna.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation on the basis of order of interim bail passed by this Court. State counsel on instructions from Inspector Vinod Kumar has not denied this fact and she further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for any custodial interrogation.

No doubt the petitioner was named in the FIR which was based on secret information and thereafter, the police laid *naka* and non-applicant/Vikas Kumar and Ankit Kumar were arrested while they were

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order
of interim bail dated 3.3.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the
conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
