Vide the instant petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0008 dated 28.01.2021, Annexure P-1, registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 354, 354-A, 377, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860, at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

It has been submitted that petitioners No.1, 3 and 4 had surrendered before the trial court and have been released on regular bail. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that insofar as petitioners No.1 and 4 are concerned, the petition qua them was rendered infructuous vide order dated 02.03.2021. He submits that insofar as petitioner No.3 is concerned, the petition has become infructuous qua him also.

Ordered accordingly.

Upon instructions from ASI Sudarshna, State counsel submits that petitioner No.2, who is the mother-in-law of the complainant, has joined the investigation in deference to order dated 13.09.2021 passed by this Court and she is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and as per the statement of the State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.09.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner No.2 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
