AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 55, dated 14th February, 2020, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149 and 307 of Indian Penal code, 1860 registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak. Earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 12th August, 2021.
2. One of the main ground for seeking regular bail is that there is no progress in the trial.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that complainant is yet to be examined and an earnest effort would be made to examine the complainant expeditiously.
4. In view of the statement made by State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to revive the prayer at a later stage.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examination of the complainant, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
