HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that while the petitioner was in service, certain punishments were imposed upon the petitioner by stopping his increments with or without cumulative effect starting from the year 2006 till the year 2010. Learned counsel submits that the increments which were stopped without cumulative effect, were to be released by the respondents but no order was passed by the respondents to release the same so as to increase the pay of the petitioner after the expiry of the punishment, which act of the respondents is causing prejudice to the petitioner and the respondents are liable to be directed to release the pending increments of the petitioner along with consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner by way of a representation dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-5), which is pending consideration with respondent No.4 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, respondent No.4 is directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding representation dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioner, in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated 27.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
