By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of '*mandamus*' directing respondent no. 3, i.e. the Estate Officer, Union Territory, Sector 17, Chandigarh, for adjudication of the matter in compliance with the remand order dated 21.01.2020, passed by respondent no. 2, i.e. the Secretary Estates, Union Territory, Chandigarh, which he says has not been finally adjudicated as yet.

He further seeks that a direction be issued for the allotment of a flat in lieu of '*Jhuggi*' no. 198-C, Colony no. 4, Chandigarh, under the Small Flat Scheme, 2006, and the order passed by the learned appellate authority dated 21.01.2020 (copy Annexure P-2) may be complied with in its letter and spirit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he restricts his prayer that a decision be taken on his case after it was remanded to the Estate Officer, vide the order passed the Secretary Estates, Union Territory, Chandigarh on 21.01.2020.

Mr. Namit Kumar, Advocate, appearing for the Union Territory, Chandigarh, submits that in fact the petitioner was thereafter called to appear before the Screening Committee in the month of February 2022 and a decision would be taken on the issue within 03 months.

Ms. Deepali Puri, Advocate, also appears for the respondent- Chandigarh Housing Board, (both on advance notice received).

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the case of the petitioner, in terms of the order dated 21.01.2020, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
