This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.649 dated 20.09.2021, registered under Sections 323,201,307,34 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

The FIR in the present case has been registered on the complaint of one Jai Karan, who stated that on 20.09.2021, he was coming back from the barber shop after getting his hair shaved. On the way, two young men came on a motorcycle. The pillion rider of the motorcycle fired at the complainant. The shot hit on the right elbow of the complainant. The complainant was taken to Government Hospital, Assandh in an ambulance. He suspected that Karan, Amanpreet @ Aman and Rahul were the assailants. It has come during investigation that co-accused Amanpreet was the pillion rider on the motorcycle which was being driven by accused Ranjeet. Amanpreet had fired a shot with a country made .315 bore pistol at the complainant. The name of the petitioner is alleged to have surfaced in the disclosure statement of one Princepal Singh who stated that the pistol

used in the crime was handed over to the petitioner and he had concealed the same in his house. The said pistol has been recovered on the disclosure statement of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 26.10.2021. The investigation is complete. The petitioner has not been attributed any overt act. The only allegation against him is that the pistol used in the crime was handed over to him for keeping in his house.

In view of the aforesaid, after considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 26.10.2021 and the trial of the case may take long time, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

This criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner-Satnam Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
