Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.126 dated 05.12.2017, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that a sum of ₹50,000/- was paid by the complainant to the petitioner for getting a job for his son.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 03.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
