ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking his release on interim bail to enable him to attend the marriage of his cousin.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an undertrial in FIR No.297 dated 27.09.2020, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 201 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Uchana, Jind. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 1 ½ years. He is not involved in any other criminal case. The marriage of the petitioner's cousin, who is the daughter of his paternal aunt is to take place on 04.03.2022. The parents of the petitioner have expired and it is the petitioner who will be performing the ceremonies on behalf of his parents. He has referred to the invite at Annexure P-3.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. He, upon instructions from

Inspector Somveer Dhaka, submits that it has been verified that the marriage of the cousin of the petitioner is to take place in village Bibipur, District Jind.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody for over 1 ½ years. He is not involved in any other case. It would be in the interest of justice, if the petitioner is permitted to attend the marriage of his cousin as the parents of the petitioner have expired.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner would be released on interim bail on 03.03.2022 to enable him to attend the marriage of his cousin subject to his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate and he would surrender before the concerned Jail at 05:00 p.m. on 05.03.2022. He will not enter the limits of village Sedha Majra as the relatives of the deceased and other witnesses are stated to be residing at that village.

At the time of release of the petitioner, the SHO, Police Station Uchana shall be informed. He shall furnish his mobile number to the SHO and keep his mobile location on till the time he surrenders before the concerned jail.
