This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the even of arrest in FIR no.37 dated 30.03.2021 registered under Sections 379B(2), 34 IPC (Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 411, 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Verka, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 7 days of moving the said application.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn,

period of 10 days and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 7 days from the date of the said application being moved.
