In the present case, following order was passed by this Court on
15.02.2019 at the time of issuance of notice of motion:-

“At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner does not wish to press the prayer with regard to challenge to charge-sheet dated 03.01.2019 and he restricts his prayer only for the release of retiral benefits such as pension, leave, GPF etc. which have to be released even though there might be a charge sheet pending against an employee.

Notice of motion for 28.05.2019.”

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of the present petition, all the benefits, for which, the petitioner is entitled for, have already been released to him.

That being so, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition. In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he will be at liberty to approach the respondents by way of filing appropriate

representation and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents will be under an obligation to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

The present petition stands disposed of in above terms.
